

Here's how it all started. In February, Third Act VTers Ed Cremo and Shaun Deane contacted the Third Act Pennsylvania working group to explore partnering in support of democracy. Since then, a group of Third Act VTers, together with members of other eastern Third Act working groups, has met monthly to

send postcards. At first, we targeted Pennsylvania voters to remind them to re-register for mail-in ballots. In March we began postcarding to support important campaigns in PA, AZ, MT, OH, NY, and CA. Since August, we have refocused on Get Out the Vote in PA, and the scripts and targeted voters reflect this.

At the recent Third Act Central "All In," Bill McKibben made a strong rallying cry and featured how working group efforts (including ours!) will affect the outcome of this important election. He mentioned the impact of our partnerships across working groups with a particular focus on swing states such as Pennsylvania.

Decarbonization Action Team Update

Third Act VT's Decarbonization Action Team (DAT), formerly named the Divestment Action Team, will meet with the VT Treasurer's Office to develop a decarbonization plan with the Vermont Pension Investment Commission (VPIC) as an alternative to divestment from fossil fuels. A decarbonization plan would call for VPIC to develop a way to achieve net-zero emissions in its portfolio by a certain date.

Watch the short and informative <u>Why We're Moo-ving Toward Decarboniza-</u><u>tion</u> on YouTube by Bloomberg Green. It explains why the concrete, steel, and agriculture industries are critical to reducing greenhouse gas emissions to mitigate climate change.

The Divestment Action Team (DAT) worked over the past two years to craft and support the fossil fuel divestment bill (S.42), which passed in the Vermont State Senate but didn't pass in the House Government Operations and Military Affairs Committee in April 2024. The DAT has shifted its focus to decarbonization for the upcoming legislative session.

Voting Action Team Appeal

In these final days of the presidential campaign, let's roll up our sleeves and do whatever we can to help elect Kamala Harris and Tim Walz! Third Act's two primary goals are preserving our democracy and protecting our planet. Defeating Trump is essential to both.

According to pollsters and political journalists, seven swing states will decide who wins the election, possibly by as little as a few thousand votes: Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin. Getting out the vote in these states is the whole battle. In his Substack newsletter, independent journalist Dave Margulius offers these <u>actions you</u> <u>can take</u>.



- Phone/virtual: Make calls to get out the vote; staff voter assistance and ballot cure hotlines.
- Make a trip: Go help local groups get out the vote, or serve as a poll monitor or observer.
- Spread the word: Share this guide widely; we need everyone in the fight.

If you have family or friends in swing states, please contact them and encourage them to vote not just for Harris but also for key congressional and other down-ballot candidates, especially for Senate seats. Independent journalist Dan Pfeiffer offers tips for convincing people to vote for Harris.

It's not too late to make donations to support key candidates in swing states. I'm confident your donations will be graciously and gratefully accepted. Remember 2016! Hillary Clinton won the popular vote by more than 3 million votes yet lost the election in the Electoral College.

Senior-to-Senior Youth Voter Registration

Please consider supporting your local high school fall voter registration drives before the November election! This is a critically important election, and young people are concerned about the environment and vote accordingly. Third Act VT has an important role to play in welcoming youths into our democracy and instilling a lifelong interest in voting and good citizenship.

Join us in working with <u>Third Act</u> national and <u>The Civics Center</u> on this initiative. Learn more and preview the resources available to schools on The Civics Center's website. Third Act VT is also collaborating with the League of Women Voters of Vermont's (<u>LWVVT</u>) high school voter registration efforts.

As of May 2024, Third Act Vermonters were working on Senior-to-Senior in one-third of our high schools (out of 90 total schools). Our allies in the LWVVT were working in another 10 percent. Many report having fun, feeling satisfied with their work, and feeling pleased to promote this key action for democracy.

Third Act Vermont Handout

This is the latest <u>TA VT handout</u> in PDF form. Feel free to print it and share it with friends, distribute it at community events, post it on grocery store bulletin boards, etc. Print it on 8.5 by 11-inch paper on both sides. You may have good luck with a local print shop that can print the sheets double-sided, then cut them into four quarters. We recommend using light card stock, not plain paper. You may want to print 10 sheets and cut them into quarters, which gives you 40 handouts and should be relatively inexpensive.
